

Rudd-Rockford-Marble Rock Community Schools (Including Learning Plans)

Return to Learn Plan 2022-2023 School Year

The plans outlined below will be put into motion when the local situation relating to Covid-19 warrants their implementation. Moving from "normal" school to one of the plans below will be announced via JMC before the change in instructional models is made.

What we know:

- Have increased custodial hours for increased cleaning.
- Cleaning and sanitizing of surfaces will take place throughout the day as needed as well as at the end of the day.
- Cleaning supplies and hand sanitizer will be provided to each classroom and replenished as needed for daily use.
- Teachers will have barriers placed around desks when requested.
- Students coming to the nurse's office for medication or first aid will use Robin's office. For those students who are ill and/or show symptoms of COVID-19 will be sent to the triage room next to the elementary conference room. Any student with a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher will be sent home.

What else we know

- Signage will be placed around the building as appropriate to the situation/place with reminders to social distance, wash hands, etc.
- Athletics will follow the guidelines of their respective Union and Association.
- Refillable stations remain open.
- Congregating in hallways will not take place.
- Elementary students should not arrive before 8:05 to avoid waiting with other students.

As a reminder

- As school resumes, we will be limiting the traffic in the building. Parents will be asked to call the building offices prior to arriving if they need to enter the building. When dropping off/picking up students outside of regular start and end times, we ask you to call the office and the child will be sent to your vehicle and signed out by the office staff.
- The school district will collaborate with the Iowa Department of Public Health, local community health officials, and our district leadership teams to continue to track community activity on the spread of the virus. Decisions will be made collaboratively and be communicated immediately.

Our Three Plans

On-Site Learning: (100% of students on site) In-person learning where learners go to the physical building to complete learning tasks.

Hybrid Learning: (Majority of students on site) Due to the availability of space in our elementary building, our goal is to have all of our students onsite, five days per week. A mixture of Continuous/Distance Learning could take place at the secondary level to accommodate for space and students. Breakfast and lunch will be in classrooms.

Elementary : Specials will be in classrooms and other movement and transitions throughout the building will be limited.

Secondary: Students will stay in pods and not leave classrooms. Stronger transitions to move students throughout the building will be enforced.

Continuous/Distance Learning: (0% of students on site) Learners are at home and are not in the school building as they complete their learning tasks for up to 14 days. Instruction is required and attendance will be taken.
